In the last few years, it's been incredible to see undocumented immigrants courageously gathering, organizing, demonstrating for reform, outing themselves as undocumented. Yesterday marked [the beginning of the Obama administration's new policy](#) of allowing immigrants brought to the country as children to apply for the temporary right to stay here—without a path to citizenship, but without fear of deportation, either.
